### AGES 13–15

#### Quest

Creativity, outdoor adventure, and teamwork. Building friendships and confidence in a small, supportive group.

### AGES 16+

#### Experience

Real-world independence skills — budgeting, travel, community. Getting ready for adult life, together.

Who can join? Young people aged 13–18 with SEND, an EHCP, or identified additional needs — including learning, social, and emotional needs. Funded places available through Harrow Council and Buckinghamshire Council short breaks budgets. Many families qualify without any extra cost.
